Hyggeligt is still THE place to get the Kaffe Fassett Collective in Canada, but the store also carries the full line of Tula Pink, Dutch Heritage and more, all available online and in person. She is also a Bernina dealer, and Hyggeligt is now a Certified Quiltworx Shop, with week-long workshops available. She even arranges travel tours and more- one busy lady! Whew!



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
